Travelling in a continuous circuit, the shuttle operates between 10.30am – 6.00pm and 6.30pm - 12.30am. It connects all properties, including the Resort Shopping Centre and Visitors Centre.</p>

<p><b>Uluru Kata-Tjuṯa National Park Entry Fee</b></p> <p>There is a National Park Entry Fee for access into the Uluru Kata-Tjuṯa National Park. This ticket is valid for 3 days. Most tours do not include this fee. National Park tickets can only be purchased from the National Park Entry Station.</p>	
<p><b>Touring Options</b></p> <p>There are many touring options available in Central Australia. We strongly recommend that you pre-book all touring to avoid disappointment. Bookings can be made with the Voyages Travel Centre. Please visit our website for additional touring options. Child rates apply to children 5-15 years inclusive.</p>

The tour includes a visit to Muṯiṯjulu waterhole in the shadow of Uluru.</p> <p>Tour departs approximately 1 hour before sunrise, (timings change due to season) and returns approximately 5 hours later. <p><b>Aboriginal Uluru Tour – Anangu Tours (easy 2km walk)</b></p> <p>After enjoying the sunrise with breakfast as you overlook Uluru join your Aboriginal guides on the famous Liru Walk as you retrace the path of the Liru Ancestors through the bushland near Uluru. See demonstrations of ancient bush skills such as making kiti (bush glue), making fire without matches and carving wooden tools with only a sharpened stone. Learn to hold and throw a spear. Tour departs approximately one hour prior to sunrise. <p><b>Camel Express – Uluru Camels</b></p> <p>Catch the Camel Train and ride our good-natured camels for 45 minutes through desert landscape with views of Uluru and Kata Tjuta. <p><b>Uluru Sunrise &amp; Guided Cultural Base Walk – AAT Kings (easy walk)</b></p> <p>Rise early this morning and travel to the Uluru sunrise viewing area to see the Red Centre set alight by the first rays of sun. Enjoy a warming cup of tea or coffee as the colours of Uluru gradually change as the sun rises on the horizon. Commence a base tour of Uluru, including a guided walk into Mutitjula waterhole. View Aboriginal rock paintings and learn about the flora, fauna and Aboriginal history from your Driver/Guide. Continue around the base of Uluru by coach and see various sacred areas. Visit the Uluru – Kata Tjuta Cultural Centre where there is time to read the Tjukurpa (Aboriginal law) or purchase some locally made Aboriginal art. The tour visits vast salt lakes that are remnants of ancient inland oceans and examines fossilized remains. As you circle Mt Connor by 4WD you'll be surprised to find a hidden series of rugged gorges, a perfect haven for Red Kangaroos and Rock Wallabies. Enjoy a glass of champagne as the sun goes down over the changing colour of Mt Connor. Then drive to Curtin Springs to enjoy a three-course dinner prepared by the station cook, before returning to your hotel. Tour departs approximately 2.30pm and returns 9.30pm. Aboriginal Guides provide an introduction to their culture, then join the artists to complete your own painting, which you can take home as a personal memento. Tour departs approximately at 2.00pm. <p><b>Kata Tjuta Valley of the Winds Walk, Sunset &amp; Barbecue Dinner – AAT Kings</b></p> <p>This afternoon your guide will escort you on a 2-3 hour walk through the Kata Tjuta domes to the Valley of the Winds lookout. The walking path is rocky, and requires a good level of fitness. After the walk, take in a magnificent 'outback' sunset. Refresh yourself with a glass of sparkling wine before continuing on to enjoy a traditional Australian barbecue dinner consisting with steak, sausages, kangaroo meat, salads and bread, complimented by Australian sparkling wine. There is time for stargazing too (weather permitting). Tea and coffee provided. Vegetarian meals can be organised. (Note: During the hotter months of the year the National Park Rangers may preclude access to the Valley of the Winds lookout. This will be substituted with the Walpa Gorge walk.)
